Jeremiah 31: 31-34

La Lección Segunda The Second Lesson Juan 12: 20-33 John 12: 20-33

Entre la gente que había ido a Jerusalén a adorar durante la fiesta, había algunos griegos. Éstos se acercaron a Felipe, que era de Betsaida, un pueblo de Galilea, y le rogaron: "Queremos ver a Jesús." Felipe fue y se lo dijo a Andrés, y los dos fueron a contárselo a Jesús. O Dios, glorifica tu nombre." Entonces se oyó una voz del cielo, que decía: "Ya lo he glorificado, y lo voy a glorificar otra vez." La gente que estaba allí escuchando, decía que había sido un trueno; pero algunos afirmaban: "Un ángel le ha hablado a Jesús." Very truly, I tell you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains just a single grain, but if it dies it bears much fruit. Those who love their life lose it, and those who hate their life in this world will keep it for eternal life. Whoever serves me must follow me, and where I am, there will my servant be also. Whoever serves me, God will honor. Now my soul is troubled. And what should I say: 'O God, save me from this hour'? No, it is for this reason that I have come to this hour. O God, glorify your name." Then a voice came from heaven, "I have glorified it, and I will glorify it again." The crowd standing there heard it and said that it was thunder. Others said, "An angel has spoken to Jesus." Jesus answered, "This voice has come for your sake, not for mine. Now is the judgment of this world; now the ruler of this world will be driven out. And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all people to myself." Jesus said this to indicate the kind of death he was to die.




