The First Lesson

The Second Lesson

Jesús nació en Belén, un pueblo de la región de Judea, en el tiempo en que Herodes era gobernante del país. In the time of Herod, after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea, magi from the east came to Jerusalem, asking, "Where is the child who has been born ruler of the Hebrew people? For we observed the child's star in the east and have come to pay homage." When Herod heard this, he was frightened, and all Jerusalem with him, and calling together all the chief priests and scribes of the people, Herod inquired of them where the Messiah was to be born. They said, "In Bethlehem of Judea, for so it has been written by the prophet: 'And you, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah, for from you shall come a ruler who is to shepherd my people Israel.'" Then Herod secretly called for the magi and learned from them the exact time when the star had appeared. Then Herod sent them to Bethlehem, saying, "Go and search diligently for the child, and when you have found this child, bring me word so that I may also go and pay homage." When they had heard the king, they set out, and there, ahead of them, went the star that they had seen in the east, until it stopped over the place where the child was. When they saw that the star had stopped, they were overwhelmed with joy. On entering the house, they saw the child with Mary his mother, and they knelt down and paid the child homage. Then, opening their treasure chests, they offered gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. And having been warned in a dream not to return to Herod, they left for their own country by another road.



Background about Sugarcane Film

One group of Americans whose painful history is often ignored are those identified as Native or Indigenous people, also known as Indians. These first human inhabitants in North America (both Canada and U.S.) were subjected to massive violence to clear them from the land—according to historians, when European settlers arrived in the Americas there were over 10 million Native Americans living here. By 1900, their estimated population was under 300,000. One of the most horrific practices in the 19th and 20th centuries was the establishment of “Indian Residential Schools” mostly operated by religious institutions. Youth were forced to leave their tribal communities and families and live in dormitories, be punished for using their tribal language and spiritual ways, and forced to learn “how to become Americans/ Canadians.” There was much violence, sexual violation and other ugliness. This film records the stories of some native residents of Canada and their descendants as they struggle to build new lives.
