THE LESSON

La Lección Primera Isaías 6: 1-8
The First Lesson Isaíah 6: 1-8

El año en que murió el gobernante Ozías, vi a Dios sentado en un trono muy alto; el borde de el manto de Dios Ilenaba el templo. Unos seres como de fuego estaban por encima de Dios. Cada uno tenía seis alas. Con dos alas se cubrían la cara, con otras dos se cubrían la parte inferior del cuerpo y con las otras dos volaban. Y se decían el uno al otro: "Santo, santo, santo es Dios todopoderoso; toda la tierra está llena de la gloria de Dios." Al resonar esta voz, las puertas del templo temblaron, y el templo mismo se llenó de humo. Y pensé: "¡Ay de mí, voy a morir! He visto con mis ojos al Soberano, a Dios todopoderoso; yo, que soy una persona de labios impuros y vivo en medio de un pueblo de labios impuros." En ese momento uno de aquellos seres como de fuego voló hacia mí. Con unas tenazas sostenía una brasa que había tomado de encima del altar, y tocándome con ella la boca, me dijo: "Mira, esta brasa ha tocado tus labios. Yo respondí: "Aquí estoy yo, envíame a mí."

In the year that the ruler Uzziah died, I saw God sitting on a throne, high and lofty, and the hem of the robe of God filled the temple. The pivots on the thresholds shook at the voices of those who called, and the house filled with smoke. And I said, "Woe is me! Lucas 5: 1-11
The Second Lesson
Luke 5: 1-11

En una ocasión, estando Jesús a orillas del Lago de Genesaret, se sentía apretujado por la multitud que quería oír el mensaje de Dios. Jesús vio dos barcas en la playa. Los pescadores habían bajado de ellas a lavar sus redes. Jesús subió a una de las barcas, que era de Simón, y le pidió que la alejara un poco de la orilla. Luego Jesús se sentó en la barca, y desde allí comenzó a enseñar a la gente. Cuando terminó de hablar, Jesús le dijo a Simón: "Lleva la barca a la parte honda del lago, y echen allí sus redes, para pescar." Simón le contestó a Jesús: "Maestro, hemos estado trabajando toda la noche sin pescar nada; pero, ya que tú lo mandas, voy a echar las redes." Cuando lo hicieron, recogieron tanto pescado que las redes se rompían. Entonces hicieron señas a sus compañeros de la otra barca, para que fueran a ayudarlos. Ellos fueron, y llenaron tanto las dos barcas que les faltaba poco para hundirse. Al ver esto, Simón Pedro se puso de rodillas delante de Jesús y le dijo: "¡Apártate de mí, Soberano, porque soy un pecador!" Es que Simón y todos los demás estaban asustados por aquella gran pesca que habían hecho. También lo estaban Santiago y Juan, niños de Zebedeo, que eran compañeros de Simón. Pero Jesús le dijo a Simón: "No tengas miedo; desde ahora vas a pescar las personas." Entonces llevaron las barcas a tierra, lo dejaron todo y se fueron con Jesús.

+ Esta es la Palabra de Dios TE ALABAMOS, O DIOS Once while Jesus was standing beside the Lake of Gennesaret and the crowd was pressing in on him to hear the word of God, Jesus saw two boats there at the shore of the lake; the fishers had gotten out of them and were washing their nets. Jesus got into one of the boats, the one belonging to Simon, and asked Simon to put out a little way from the shore. Then Jesus sat down and taught thecrowds from the boat. When Jesus had finished speaking, he saidto Simon, "Put out into the deep water and let down your nets for a catch." Simon answered, "Teacher, we have worked all night long but have caught nothing. Yet if you say so, I will let down the nets." When they had done this, they caught so many fish that their nets were beginning to burst. So they signaled their partners in the other boat to come and help them. And they came and filled both boats, so that they began to sink. But when Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus's knees, saying, "Go away from me, Sovereign, for I am a sinful person!" For Simon and all who were with him were astounded at the catch of fish that they had taken, and so also were James and John, children of Zebedee, who were partners with Simon. Then Jesus said to Simon, "Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching people." When they had brought their boats to shore, they left everything and followed Jesus.

IF ICE COMES TO YOUR DOOR



DO NOT OPEN DOORS

ICE cannot come in without a signed warrant by a criminal court judge. They can only come in if you let them.



REMAIN SILENT

ICE can use anything you say against you in your immigration case so claim your right to remain silent!

*Say "I plead the fifth amendment and choose to remain silent".



DO NOT SIGN

Don't sign anything ICE gives you without talking to an attorney.



REPORT & RECORD!

Report immediately: UWD hotline 1-844-363-1423.

Take pictures & video unless you're on federal government property.

Take notes of badge numbers, number of agents, time, type of car and exactly what happened!



FIGHT BACK!

Get a trustworthy attorney & explore all options to fight your case. If detained, you may be able to get bail - don't give up hope! Join your local team to defend yourself from enforcement!



Know Your PowerRecord and Report:



Step 2 - Get information of the officer's, name, badge and agency.

Step 3 - Narrate the date, time and location of event.

Step 4 - Do not disclose the information of your loved ones or yourself to the agents.

Step 5 - Report it to the **MigraWatch** Hotline and send your video/pics to migrawatch@unitedwedream.org

Always remember you have the power to make choices, you have a choice over your safety, how you respond and what you choose to share.
