THE LESSON

La Lección Primera
The First Lesson

Isaías 56: 1-8
Isaiah 56: 1-8

Dios dice: “Practiquen la justicia, hagan lo que es recto, porque pronto voy a llevar a cabo la liberación; voy a mostrar mi poder salvador. Dichoso la persona que sigue estos mandatos y los cumple con fidelidad, que respeta el sábado y no lo profana, que tiene buen cuidado de no hacer nada malo. Si un extranjero se entrega a Dios, no debe decir: ‘Dios me tendrá separado del pueblo de Dios.’ Ni tampoco el eunuco debe decir: ‘Yo soy un árbol seco.’” Porque Dios dice: “Si los eunucos respetan mis sábados, y si cumplen mi voluntad y se mantienen firmes en mi alianza, yo les daré algo mejor que hijos e hijas; les concederé que su nombre quede grabado para siempre en mi templo, dentro de mis muros; les daré un nombre eterno, que nunca será borrado. Y a los extranjeros que se entreguen a mí, para servirme y amarme, para ser mis siervos, si respetan el sábado y no lo profanan y se mantienen firmes en mi alianza, yo los traeré a mi monte sagrado y los haré felices en mi casa de oración. Yo aceptaré en mi altar sus holocaustos y sacrificios, porque mi casa será declarada casa de oración para todos los pueblos. Yo haré que vuelvan y se reúnan los que aún están en el destierro.” Esto lo afirma Dios, que hace que vuelvan a reunirse los israelitas que estaban dispersos.

TE ALABAMOS, O DIOS

Thus says God: “Maintain justice, and do what is right, for soon my salvation will come and my deliverance be revealed. Happy is the mortal who does this, the one who holds it fast, who keeps the Sabbath, not profaning it, and refrains from doing any evil. Do not let the foreigner joined to God say, ‘God will surely separate me from the people of God,’ and do not let the eunuch say, ‘I am just a dry tree.’” For thus says God: “To the eunuchs who keep my Sabbaths, who choose the things that please me and hold fast my covenant, I will give, in my house and within my walls, a monument and a name better than sons and daughters; I will give them an everlasting name that shall not be cut off. And the foreigners who join themselves to God, to minister to God, to love the name of God, and to be the servants of God, all who keep the Sabbath and do not profane it and hold fast my covenant—these I will bring to my holy mountain and make them joyful in my house of prayer; their burnt offerings and their sacrifices will be accepted on my altar, for my house shall be called a house of prayer for all peoples.” Thus says God, who gathers the outcasts of Israel: “I will gather others to them besides those already gathered.”

Marcos 3: 22-35
Mark 3: 22-35

Los maestros de la ley que habían llegado de Jerusalén decían: “Beelzebú, el propio jefe de los demonios, es quien le ha dado a Jesus el poder de expulsarlos.” Jesús los llamó, y les puso un ejemplo, diciendo: “¿Cómo puede Satanás expulsar al propio Satanás? Un país dividido en bandos enemigos, no puede mantenerse; y una familia dividida, no puede mantenerse. Así también, si Satanás se divide y se levanta contra Satanás, no podrá mantenerse; habrá llegado el fin de Satanás. Pues cualquiera que hace la voluntad de Dios, ése es mi hermano, mi hermana y mi madre.”

The scribes who came down from Jerusalem said, "Jesus has Beelzebul, and by the ruler of the demons he casts out demons." And Jesus called them and spoke to them in parables, "How can Satan cast out Satan? If a reign is divided against itself, that reign cannot stand. And if a house is divided against itself, that house will not be able to stand. And if Satan has risen up against Satan and is divided, Satan cannot stand, but the end of Satan has come. No one can enter a strong person's house and plunder the property without first tying up the strong person; then indeed the house can be plundered. Truly I tell you, people will be forgiven for their sins and whatever blasphemies they utter, but whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit can never have forgiveness but is guilty of an eternal sin"— for they had said, "Jesus has an unclean spirit." Then the mother of Jesus and his siblings came, and standing outside they sent to Jesus. A crowd was sitting around, and they said to Jesus, "Your mother and your siblings are outside asking for you." And Jesus replied, "Who are my mother and my siblings?" And looking at those who sat around him, Jesus said, "Here are my mother and my brothers and my sisters! Whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother."

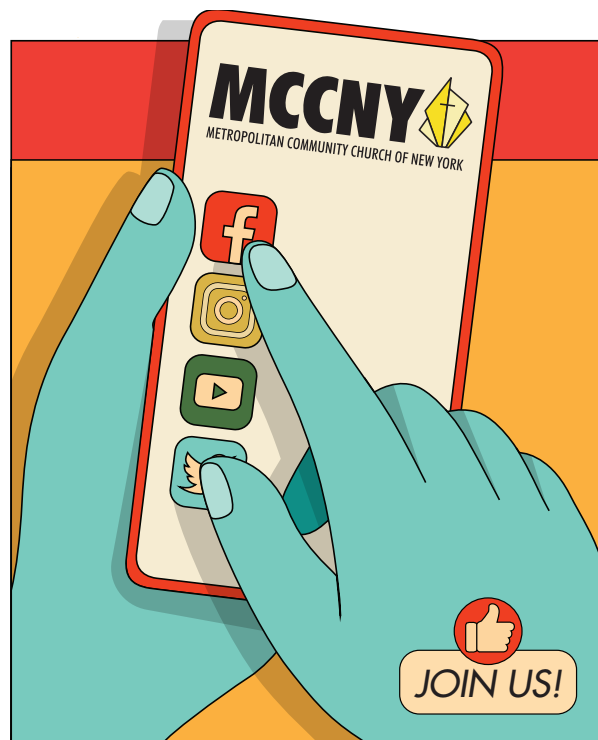

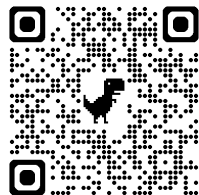

**WHAT TO DO
IF ICE COMES TO YOUR DOOR**



DO NOT OPEN DOORS

ICE cannot come in without a signed warrant
by a criminal court judge. They can only come
in if you let them.



REMAIN SILENT

ICE can use anything you say against you in
your immigration case so claim your right
to remain silent!

**Say "I plead the fifth amendment and choose to remain silent".*



DO NOT SIGN

Don't sign anything ICE gives you without
talking to an attorney.



REPORT & RECORD!

Report immediately: UWD hotline 1-844-363-1423.

Take pictures & video unless you're on federal
government property.
Take notes of badge numbers, number of agents,
time, type of car and exactly what happened!



FIGHT BACK!

Get a trustworthy attorney & explore all
options to fight your case. If detained, you
may be able to get bail - don't give up hope!
Join your local team to defend yourself from
enforcement!
